










## Please note the types of tutors in your program




## Is your writing center already certified through an existing organization?






## Have you explored certification options but not pursued them?




What elements of writing center life or practice do you think should be valued in the certification process? Please select all that apply.




Does your writing center incorporate national frameworks into training and professional development programs or writing center documents?






## Does your program provide and require training for staffers as part of their hiring or employment?
